Now you have to know that this couple has been married over 50 years, and they have a special love story. But as you also probably suspect, they’ve had many ups-and-downs. They have endured many trials, disappointments and struggles. Through all of these, they held on, as the wife stayed faithful to her Lord and prayed for her husband’s salvation. Through the years, as she loved and prayed for him, I can recall her saying to me several times, “I don’t know what is taking him so long to see how good God is and give his life to Him”. Our conversation always ended with “We pray God responds quickly...” (Always recognizing that it’s never our job to figure out the when and how!

So, as we three were finishing our visit, I asked if it would be ok to pray – and that’s we did! As we held hands, we just told our Lord how much we loved Him, and how thankful we are that he loved us. It was not an eloquent prayer, just simple words. We all three had tears streaming down our cheeks, because we know we had touched the heart of God. And we were greatly aware that we are a part of the great love story of all – “For God so loved the world, He gave!”
